## The Great Gift of Easter

It is still dark as night. The sun has not yet topped the trees. A slight breeze blows, breaking the mist into long fingers that twirl among the gravestones, wispy and white. We gather around the bonfire, a lit candle in our hands, grateful for the light and each other's company, as we wait for the dawn.

There is something so very meaningful about gathering on the edge of a cemetery to await the Easter sunrise. The contrast between darkness and light, life and death, is vivid. You can literally reach out and touch it. The memory of loved ones long gone is sharp, and the longing to see them again intense. You speak in whispers, and move slowly as you wait for the music to begin – the sound that pushes the shadows away, and makes your heart rise and fall with the melody. You yearn for the words; to hear once again the promises of Easter – the empty tomb, the angel voices, the risen Lord, alive and well! And, as the sun spills its liquid gold over you, the reality of the resurrection races through your veins, and you throw back your head, and cry, "He is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!"

We Lutherans live in the shadow of the cross. We remember the life, suffering, and death of Jesus all the time. We follow him out into the world, carrying his cross before us. But, the center of our faith is the resurrection! Because, without the resurrection, the cross would be meaningless. If God had not raised Jesus from the dead, his death would have been for nothing! But, it was not for nothing. Jesus *was* raised. Jesus *is* alive. And, because he lives, we have been given the great gift of Easter – the gift of hope. The hope that this world is not all there is. The hope we need to fully live our life today. The hope that when this temporary earthly tent in which we live wears out, we will be given a permanent room in heaven, and will see our loved ones again. And, best of all, Easter gives us the hope that we will see God face to face, and live in the joy of his presence forever!

## **Congregation Council Meeting Highlights March 6, 2011**

**Minutes** from the February 13, 2011 Council Meeting were approved.

### **Reports**

The Pastor's and the Treasurer's Reports for February 2011 were reviewed.

### **Committees**

**Property Committee:** Handed out updated jobs list. Crack in the front door of church needs repairing. Discussion of possible security systems for property and/or AC unit. Will research with insurance company. New AC unit is on order.

**Evangelism:** Donations for Lenten suppers will be for Relay for Life. April 1st is the walk. Zion will have RV on site, sell food, water, glow sticks. March 22 plan to deliver flyers about Zion's activities through Easter in nearby neighborhoods. Yard sale on May 14: Request to use stage area as storage/staging area granted if no upcoming programs.

**Stewardship/Finance.** Claim submitted for stolen AC units; estimate to replace units in both buildings \$22,531.00 with \$1000.00 deductible.

**Worship and Music:** Dedication of prayer labyrinth after worship on March 27. Services for Holy Week: Maundy Thursday, 7:00pm; Good Friday, 8:00pm; Easter Sunrise Service 6:30am. Sunday School Convention is May 1. Plan to have an abbreviated service at Zion at 8:30am and then possibly take the bus to the convention.

**Christian Education:** Discussion as to availability of Ebenezer Trustees grant for VBS, as last year's grant went to general fund. Representative Charlie Heidt assured us that if the money is needed for VBS this year, VBS will be given first priority.

**Social Ministry:** Blood Drive at Zion on May 5 with the Red Cross from 2:00pm – 7:00pm.

**Unfinished Business:** None

**New Business** Lutheran Southern Seminary invites churches to honor their pastors by making donations in their name. Discussed putting out a plate in April for donations and advertising this in the bulletin and newsletter.

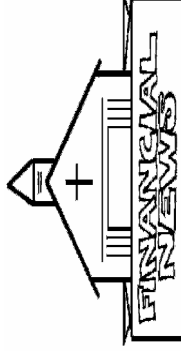

## Called Congregation Council Meeting Highlights

March 20, 2011

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the replacement of the stolen air conditioning units.

The quote from Boalen for installing a new 5 ton unit (both inside and outside portions) in the classroom portion of the church building and a 25 ton unit in the fellowship hall comes to \$22,531.00. The total amount from the insurance company will be \$19,277.00 after the \$1,000.00 deductible. This leaves a \$3,254.00 deficit that the church will need to find funds to cover.

A motion was seconded and carried to replace the entire system in the back of the church building with a vote of 9 to 1.

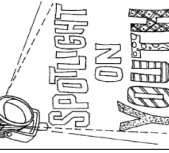

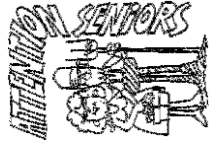

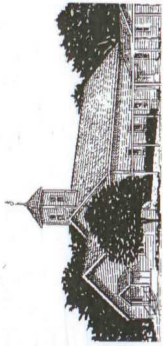
