Ah, February! That month of hearts and flowers and words of love! Whispers on the wind that Spring is just around the corner! The sun gets up just a little earlier now, and it's easier to crawl out of the covers in the morning since the thermometer has inched another degree towards *Warmth*. Today, as I stood in the haven of the woods behind our house, I, of the Perpetually Frozen Feet, was better able to enjoy the beauty of the world around me. I looked up through the trees at the early morning sky. It was that cool, blue-gray color of winter, streaked with clouds as fine and frilly as the lace on a homemade valentine – the kind I made when I was in grade school, with a red paper heart surrounded with lace, shot through with an arrow, with great, big letters that said, "Be Mine." Looking at that sky, I felt as though God had written a great, big love letter to me. The words of Isaiah 43 came rushing into my heart: "I have called you by name, you are mine. You are precious in my sight, and I love you." Have you ever heard more beautiful words than these?

How wonderful it is for me to be reminded that when God says, "You are mine," he means that I am no longer my own. I am his precious child! My Heavenly Father continues to watch over me, provide for my needs, and takes true delight in surrounding me with a beautiful home in which to live.

New Business:

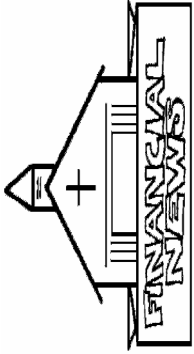
1. 2011 Budget: Stewardship and Finance Committee proposed a budget of \$160,006.00. The budget proposal was seconded and passed.

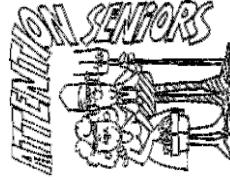
Thrivent Choice Dollars

Manna House Hours

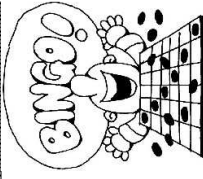
